TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WALNUT CREEK TRAIL AT US 183 EXTENDED Detour Via US 183 Shared Use Path and Sidewalks

(Austin, Texas) — Please be advised that temporary weekday closures of the Walnut Creek Trail will resume Wednesday, March 4, and last several weeks.* The Trail will close where it crosses under US 183 south of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard. Pedestrians and bicyclists should utilize the new shared use path and sidewalk along northbound and southbound US 183 and the pedestrian crossing at Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to access the opposite side of the highway. Intermittent additional closures throughout the spring may also be necessary to ensure pedestrian safety during demolition and reconstruction of the US 183 bridges across Boggy Creek.
