## FUTURE TOLL LANES TO OPEN ON SOUTHBOUND US 183 Through Traffic to Temporarily Use New Lanes

**(Austin, Texas)** — Beginning as early as Sunday, October 25, 2020\*, southbound drivers on US 183 will be temporarily directed onto the future 183 Toll Road from south of Bolm Road to SH 71. Tolls will not be charged on the southbound toll lanes south of Bolm Road during this next phase of construction.

Drivers will be able to access the newly opened lanes without paying a toll if they enter just before Bolm Road, at the Colorado River, or just south of Vargas Road. Drivers will need to enter the new lanes if they wish to continue south on US 183 past SH 71 or if they want to exit to SH 71 and Austin-Bergstrom International Airport.

Southbound drivers wishing to access Montopolis Drive, any destinations located on the southbound US 183 general-purpose lanes between the Colorado River and Patton Avenue, or the south-to-north U-turn at Patton Avenue should stay on the US 183 general-purpose lanes and not enter the newly opened toll road lanes.

The southbound US 183 general-purpose lanes will be temporarily reduced to one lane just south of Vargas Road. In the coming weeks, businesses between the East Vue Apartments and 650 Bastrop Highway will be accessed via a temporary road located just south of Vargas Road.

In addition, the existing southbound US 183 general-purpose lanes south of Patton Avenue will be permanently closed in accordance with the final project design. Drivers exiting businesses south of East Vue Apartments will now use the south-to-north U-turn at Patton Avenue to access the northbound US 183 general-purpose lanes and can make a U-turn at Montopolis Drive if they wish to head south on US 183.
