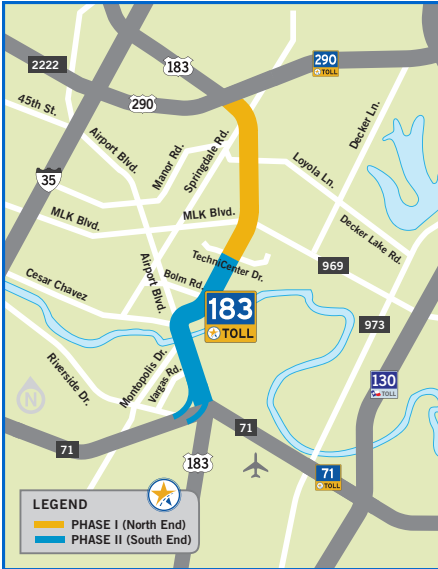




183 TOLL NORTH END

OVERVIEW

The 183 South Project is adding three tolled lanes in each direction on an 8-mile stretch of US 183 between US 290 and SH 71. When the project is complete, it will offer drivers a non-stop, signal free route to get to their destination without delay. This key north-south alternative to I-35 will provide significant improvements to the corridor including enhanced non-tolled general-purpose lanes, and an extensive network of bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

NOW OPEN: PHASE I/NORTH END

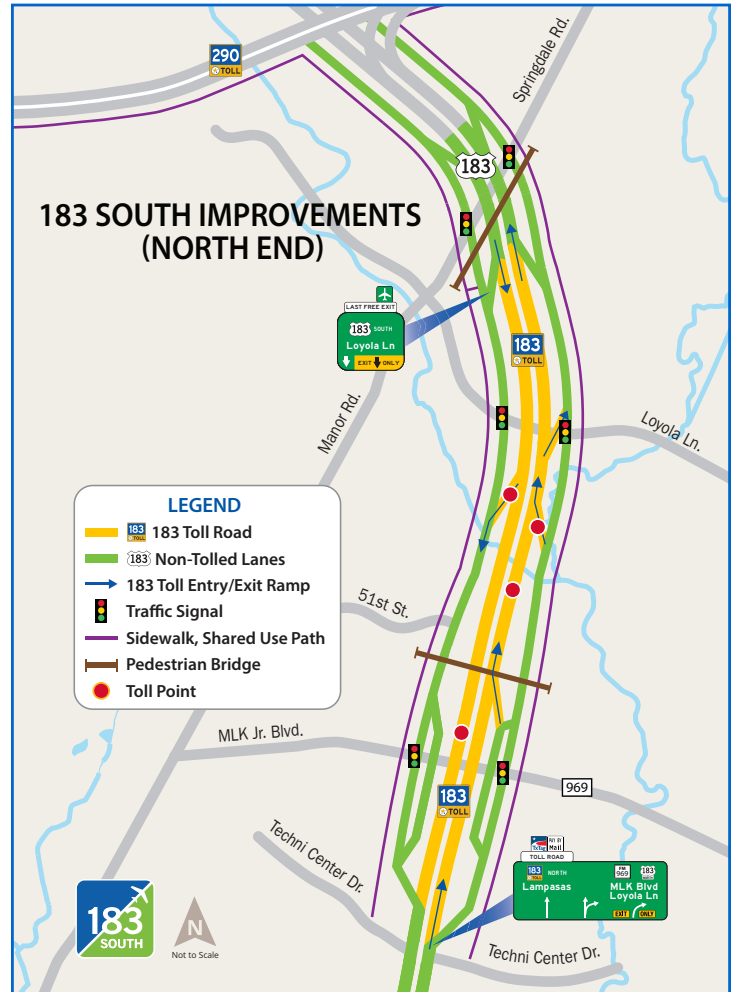


The northern half of the project is now open to traffic. Between US 290 and Techni Center Drive, drivers have

a choice to use the new tolled lanes to bypass the traffic signals at the Loyola Lane and MLK Jr. Boulevard intersections. Drivers who prefer not to pay a toll still have the option to use the improved non-tolled general-purpose lanes. Cross street intersections and pedestrian/bicycle accommodations will open in the coming weeks/months.

Customers with an active electronic tag receive a **33 percent discount** on their toll rates. The Mobility Authority accepts any of the following electronic tags: TxTag, TollTag, EZ Tag, KTAG, Pikepass, or BancPass.
