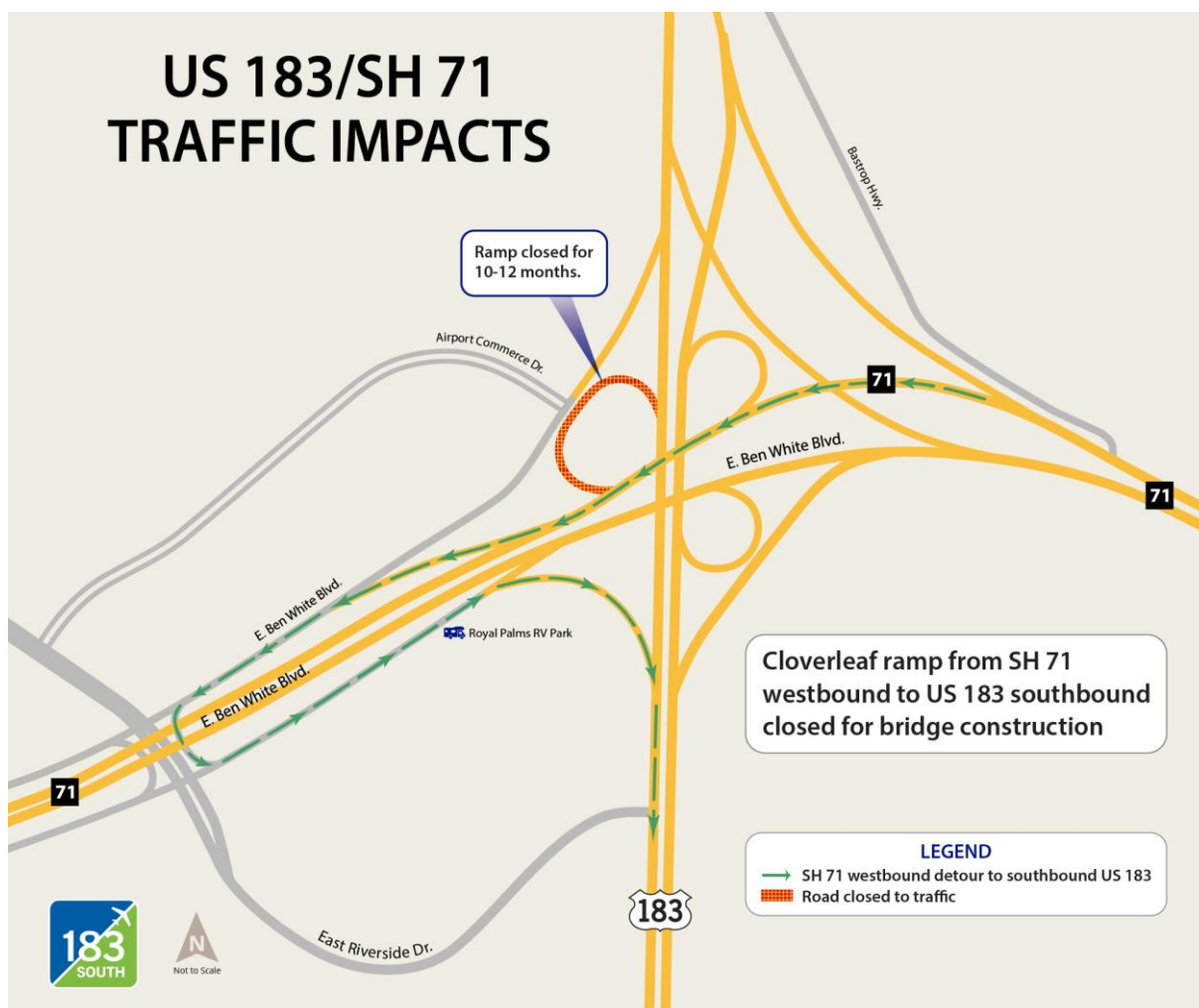

CONSTRUCTION TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE SH 71 WESTBOUND TO US 183 SOUTHBOUND CLOVERLEAF EXIT RAMP

Dear 183 South Project Neighbors,

Please be advised of upcoming travel impacts and detours that may affect access to your residence and/or business.

The cloverleaf ramp from SH 71 westbound to US 183 southbound will be CLOSED for 10-12 months starting as early as August 13, 2018.* Detour traffic will exit Riverside Drive and take the west to east U-turn to access US 183 southbound. This closure is necessary to facilitate the realignment, reconstruction, and widening of westbound SH 71.



**Dates are subject to change based on weather and other circumstances.*

Know before you go! Expect travel delays and plan accordingly.

Please Be Advised:

- **Travel delays are possible; especially during peak morning and afternoon travel times.**
- Variable message signs will alert travelers in advance of the closure.

The Mobility Authority is building a new tolled expressway with three lanes in each direction on an eight-mile section of US 183 between US 290 and SH 71. The agency is also reconstructing and improving the non-tolled US 183 general purpose lanes and adding \$25 million worth of pedestrian and bicyclist facilities. The project will open in phases between 2019 and 2020, offering greater mobility for all users of the corridor.
